| LICENSES: | Licenses are not required for this event and Zone trial skiers are not required to have a CCC licence for the BC Winter Games. |

| REGISTRATION: | Registration is via <u>Zone4</u> , fees payable by credit card only. Deadline is midnight PST December 27th. No late entries |
| START LISTS: | Start lists for the race will be posted on Zone4 by midnight Dec 29th and onsite at 9:30am of race day. |
| BIB PICKUP: | Bib pick-up will be from 9:30 – 10:30am in the rental office located on the lower level of the Rotary Nordic Lodge |
| FACILITIES: | A day lodge with First Aid facilities and indoor washrooms is on site. |
| COLD WEATHER PROVISIONS: | Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature conditions are unsuitable at start time. Notice will be posted on the event webpage. |
| | With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. |
| | For skiers born 2005 and later, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. |

| WAXING: | Indoor wax space is available, though space is limited. Outdoor electrical outlets are available along the biathlon fence. You will need to bring your own equipment. |
| CCBC Glide Wax Protocol | Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, athletes, wax technicians and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes in all age categories at all Regional Cup races. This protocol also applies to coaches, athletes, wax technicians and parents traveling to British Columbia from out-of-province or out-of-country. Low-fluoro glide waxing protocol: Structure tools ARE permitted. Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted. Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted. Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted. |
