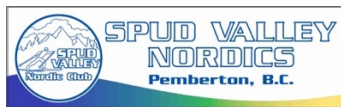

only made possible by the enormous team of volunteers that give their time and expertise. Thank you, volunteers, coaches, racers, and Whistler Olympic Park!"

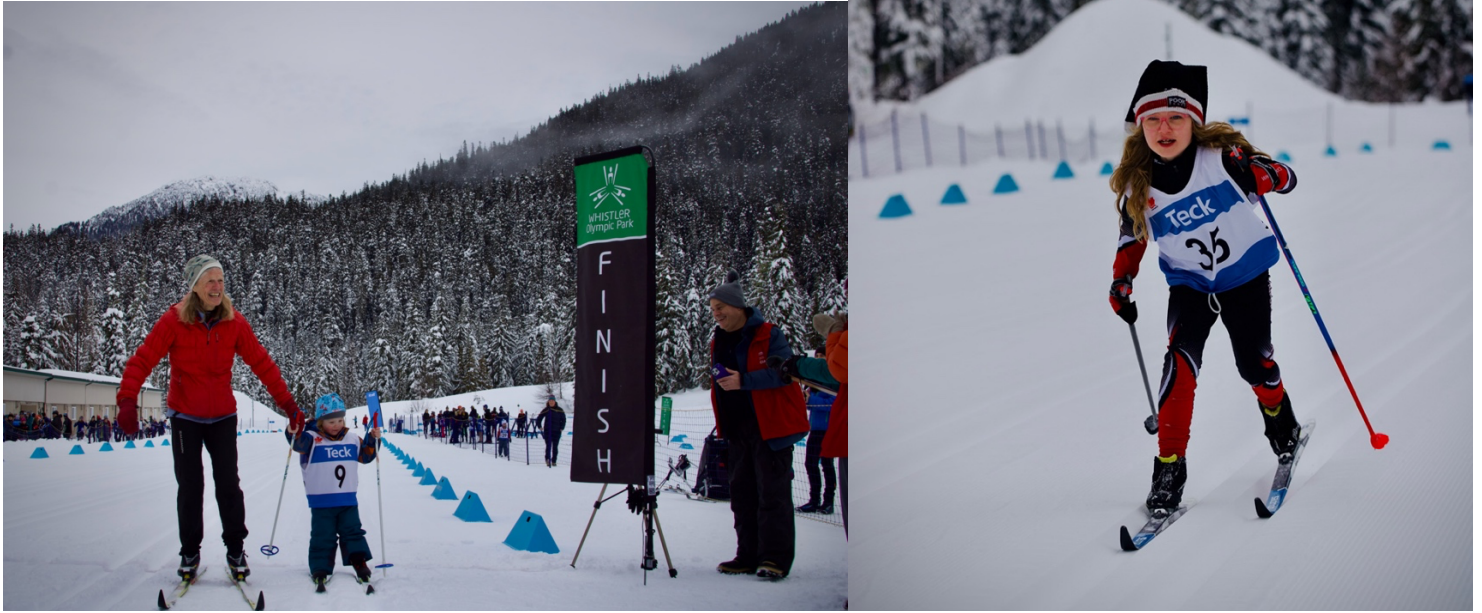
